Everyone must complete Station #2 in order to receive any other documents prior to the first day of school.</p>
Station #2 Emergency Cards	<p>Turn in completed, signed Emergency Card. Please complete information in BLUE or BLACK INK. Forms completed in pencil, or other pen colors, will not be accepted.</p> <p>A completed Emergency Card contains the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Valid parent signature 2. Completed primary, secondary and emergency contact information 3. Any additional health information <p>Students must have a valid, updated Emergency Card submitted prior to the beginning of school.</p>
Station #3	<p>ASB \$25.00</p> <p>Free into all home games, discounts on dances, and other student activities – many other school events</p>
Station #4 Yearbook	<p>Yearbook: 75.00 AT THE ORIENTATION.</p> <p><u>All Freshman, Sophomore and Junior</u> Students will have yearbook photos taken at the beginning of the school year.</p> <p><u>Seniors:</u> will take their ID photo only on school picture days. Senior picture information has been mailed home separately.</p>
Station #5 Hall Lockers	<p>Hall Lockers – <i>Optional</i></p> <p><u>You must have turned in a Emergency Card before you can get a locker</u></p> <p>For proper control and campus safety, the school requires that only school-issued locks be used on school lockers. PE and Hall locks will be provided at no charge to student. Hall Lock as well as P.E. Combination Lock must be returned at the end of the school year. If lost or damaged, students and family will be charged a replacement fee.</p> <p>*In order to sign up for a hall locker, you must also have a locker partner. Students who do not identify a locker partner will be assigned to a random partner during the first couple days of school. Lockers are assigned on a first-come/first-serve basis. No reservations will be taken in advance.</p>
Station #6 P.E. Clothing (No PE clothes will be handed out during Orientation. This is a pre-sale before school begins)	<p>All students enrolled in Physical Education classes are required to dress appropriately for fitness activities. This is important for comfort, hygiene, safety, and student recognition. We highly recommend and encourage all students to wear, with pride, the maroon and gold t-shirt and shorts. A hooded sweatshirt and our grey sweatpants with the PHS logo are available as well. No student will be denied participation in PE class, nor will any students' grade be adversely affected if the student is unable to purchase the school PE uniform. If purchasing the Piner High School PE uniform is not an option, the student may wear a solid white t-shirt, solid black shorts, and/or light gray sweatpants. The Physical Education instructor may be contacted if you have any questions.</p> <p>*T-shirt \$8.00, Shorts \$12.00, Hoodie \$18.00, Sweatpants \$17.00</p> <p>*Upon purchasing the Physical Education uniform, students will need to <u>keep their receipt</u> to show that payment has been made. All PE items will be given to students who have paid for them during the first week of school.</p>
Station #7	<p>Parent Organizations: Boosters, PTSA, Project Graduation</p>
Station #8	<p>Athletic Organizations: Students interested in participating in Fall sports must return a completed athletic packet to the Athletic Director. Some sports require baseline concussion screenings prior to participation. Please contact PHS Athletic Director OR your coach for this very important information.</p>
Station #9 Pay Station	<p>ASB (\$25), Yearbook (\$75), P.E clothes (see prices attached).</p> <p>Check, cash, or Visa credit cards are accepted. Please identify student name and ID number on your check.</p>
Station #10	<p>Pick up class schedules – your Emergency Card must be turned in before you can receive your schedule. Lunch application will be available at the orientation.</p>
