## GRADUATION FROM PINER HIGH SCHOOL WITH UP TO A YEAR OF CREDIT

Piner High School and Santa Rosa Junior College have joined in an educational partnership to offer the **Piner High School-SRJC Early College Magnet Program** to qualified incoming 9th graders. This exceptional educational opportunity provides Piner students with accelerated learning in the company of other college bound students, while preserving their high school experience in sports, drama, music, student government, and other extra-curricular activities.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- 9th and 10th graders enroll in specific classes at Piner geared toward college success.
- 11th and 12th grade students enroll in four courses at Piner and two courses per semester at SRJC.
- Support from a dedicated Piner High School counselor skilled in college preparatory assistance.
- FREE tuition and textbooks provided for up to 30 college units.
- FREE transportation to and from SRJC provided for students enrolled in college courses between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Students may choose to transfer up to one year of earned SRJC units directly to the California UC or CSU system or private institutions of higher learning, continue studies at SRJC to earn an associate degree, or complete a career certificate.
- Piner High School Early College Magnet Program students enjoy all the privileges of SRJC students, including access to all of SRJC libraries, research facilities, labs, and academic tutoring.

## PROGRAM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Students must have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
- Students must complete the program application.
- Students who meet the application requirements will be given an interview prior to acceptance into the program.

## STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

- Pursue post secondary education
- Devote minimum of two hours daily to homework
- Participate in Early College Magnet activities
- Attend SRJC counseling support classes
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average at Piner and SRJC
- Complete all Santa Rosa City Schools high school graduation requirements

## COURSES AT PINER HIGH SCHOOL:

In addition to offering rigorous academic courses leading to a high school diploma, Piner High School provides students with a wide range of honors and Advanced Placement classes. Students participating in the Early College Magnet Program are exposed to courses that challenge their academic abilities whether they are preparing for a university degree, an associate degree, or wish to pursue a career certificate. Program students may also enroll in Piner Pathway courses such as, culinary arts, construction technology, or biotechnology, all of which align with the vocational program at SRJC.

## PINER HIGH SCHOOL



Piner High School's state of the art facility includes a performing arts center, culinary arts facility, synthetic sports field and all-weather track, five high-tech science labs, and an Internet connected library and media center. Classroom technology includes connection to the Internet, as well as the most up-to-date classroom sound field equipment. The challenging academic curriculum, which includes honors and Advanced Placement courses in core classes, is delivered by highly skilled teachers who are appropriately credentialed.

## SANTA ROSA JUNIOR COLLEGE
